




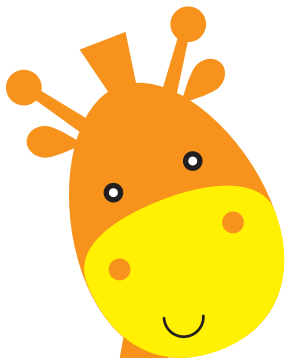
Neonatal ICU Visitation

The RNICU has an open visitation policy. To provide the best patient care possible, we are closed during the following times:

- 6:30 to 7:30 a.m. and 6:30 to 7:30 p.m. for change of shift report.
- During certain patient procedures in order to provide the best patient care.
- Quiet time is from 1 to 3 p.m. daily. Parents are welcome during this time. Grandparents may visit with parents during quiet time. No other visitors are permitted during quiet time.

Only two visitors per family may enter the unit at one time. One visitor must be a parent or significant other. While we have a liberal visitation policy for RNICU families, we recommend only immediate family for the well-being of your baby.

- Visitors must be 14 years or older.
- Grandparents may visit without a parent, (with permission given to the nurse by a parent) from 10 to 10:30 a.m. and 8 to 8:30 p.m. Grandparents may also provide care with parental permission.
- Siblings (3 years and older) may accompany parents to visit once a day for up to 15 minutes.
- Siblings must be free from any signs of illness and a health checklist must be completed before their visit occurs.
- Due to safety concerns, siblings may not hold or feed the patient during their visit.
- For the safety of your child and our patients, siblings must stay at the bedside during the visit.
- Children may not be left unattended outside the nursery.
